CALL FOR SUBMISSION OF COMMENTS AND PUBLIC PARTICIPATION ON THE REVIEW OF THE DRAFT PREVENTION OF TERRORISM (IMPLEMENTATION OF THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS ON SUPPRESSION OF TERRORISM) REGULATIONS, 2022

The Ministry of Interior and National Administration is mandated to administer policies, laws and other matters relating to prevention of terrorism and implementation of the United Nations Security Council Resolutions on the suppression of terrorism under the Prevention of Terrorism Act, 2012 (POTA).

The Anti-Money Laundering and Combating of Terrorism Financing Laws (Amendment) Act 2023 housing the POTA amendments were assented into law on 1st September 2023 and came into effect on 15th September 2023. In that regard, the Ministry of Interior and National Administration is conducting public participation on the proposed amendments to the Prevention of Terrorism (Implementation of the United Nations Security Council Resolutions on the suppression of Terrorism) Regulations, 2022 to align the regulations with the POTA. The regulations can be found on the websites of the Ministry of Interior and National Administration and the Financial Reporting Centre at www.interior.go.ke and www.frc.go.ke respectively.

The Ministry of Interior and National Administration invites members of the public and stakeholders to submit any comments, views and make any presentation regarding the draft regulations. The comments, views, representations and any written memoranda may be forwarded to MEKenya@frc.go.ke or by hand delivery to the Financial Reporting Centre at 13th Floor, UAP Old Mutual Towers, Upperhill on or before 2nd October 2023 by 5:00 PM.
