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TARGETED FINANCIAL SANCTIONS NOTICE NO. 4 OF 2025 **DELISTING FROM THE ISIL (DA'ESH) & AL-QAIDA SANCTIONS LIST**

1 Background

- 1.1 The Prevention of Terrorism Act, 2012 (POTA) and the Prevention of Terrorism (Implementation of the United Nations Security Council Resolutions on Suppression of Terrorism) Regulations, 2024 (POT-TFR) provide for the implementation of targeted financial sanctions related to terrorism financing.
- 1.2 On 9 June 2025, the United Nations Security Council made updates to the ISIL (Da'esh) & Al-Qaida Sanctions List following the removal of an entry by the United Nations Security Council Committee pursuant to resolutions 1267 (1999), 1989 (2011) and 2253 (2015) concerning ISIL (Da'esh), Al-Qaida and associated individuals, groups, undertakings and entities.
- 1.3 Therefore, the assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution 2610 (2021), and adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations no longer apply to the delisted person(s).
- 1.4 Pursuant to Regulation 13(3) of POT-TFR, the Counter Financing of Terrorism Inter-Ministerial Committee hereby circulates the delisting notification to Reporting Institutions, the Public and any other person who may be holding targeted funds or other assets of the delisted person; and provides guidance on actions to be taken following receipt of this Notice.

2 Delisted Entries

2.1 The removal from the ISIL (Da'esh) & Al-Qaida Sanctions List relate to the following entry: -

- **QDi. 328 Hajjaj Bin Fahd Al Ajmi**

3 Action to be taken

3.1 Based on the information, review whether you took a freezing action on targeted funds or other assets pursuant to resolutions 1267 (1999), 1989 (2011) and 2253 (2015) concerning the delisted person(s).

3.2 Respect the delisting and unfreeze, without delay, all targeted funds or other assets of the delisted person(s) that you or your institution holds.

3.3 Upon effecting the unfreezing action or taking any other action, file a report to the Counter Financing of Terrorism Inter-Ministerial Committee through the Secretary to the Committee via tfs@frc.go.ke, specifying the action taken.

4 Non-compliance with the provisions of the obligations provided in this Notice, or attempts to circumvent the provisions is an offense under the POT-TFR.

Security Council ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions Committee Removes One Entry from Its Sanctions List

On 9 June 2025, the Security Council Committee pursuant to resolutions 1267 (1999), 1989 (2011) and 2253 (2015) concerning ISIL (Da'esh), Al-Qaida and associated individuals, groups, undertakings and entities removed the entry below from the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions List after concluding its consideration of the delisting request for this name submitted through the Office of the Ombudsperson established pursuant to Security Council resolution 1904 (2009), and of the Comprehensive Report of the Ombudsperson on this delisting request.

Therefore, the assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution 2734 (2024) and adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations, no longer apply to the name set out below:
